

SRA Reading and Math Advanced Program Support: 2 day training

Synopsis: This advanced level professional development is designed for school leadership and teaching staff to support Reading Mastery, Corrective Reading, and Connecting Math Concepts Programs. It includes strategies to ensure continued leadership and successful implementation of the program.

Target Audience: Principals and Instructional Staff

Goals:

1. To provide specific training for organizational leadership that ensures effective implementation of Scientifically Research-Based reading and math programs.
2. To provide assistance with continuous data collection and analysis that ensures high quality instructional decision-making.

Outcomes:

- Review of skillful observations best practices.
- Analysis of accomplished short-and long-term planning for programs.
- Qualitative measurement of fidelity of implementation of SBR programs.
- Support the role of the administrator in effective instruction.
- Check consistency of use of pacing and assessment calendars.
- Check usage of consistent decision rules and movement of students to progressive tiers for instruction.
- Determine priority needs for support.
- Determine priority follow-up tasks.
- Meet with grade level teams to provide assistance in effective techniques for efficient use of the programs.
- Written summary of activities completed and support provided.

Cost:

The off-the-shelf cost for this 2-day training is \$4200. Travel expenses are additional. Total cost is \$6000.
